1- REPORT FROM THE BUREAU

Along with the report following two points concerning the Supplementary Rules and Guidelines were discussed:

Point 1: Literature Exhibit Participation under different exhibitor names

It has been reported that in some cases the same literature exhibit is displayed under different exhibitors across different exhibitions, and in IBRA one exhibit was entered in the competition by 2 different exhibitors.

In Current Supplementary Rules for the Philatelic Literature Class in FIP Exhibitions Rule 2: In amplification of Article 17.1 (GREX), entries may be exhibited by the author, compiler, editor, publisher, sponsoring organization or society, or any other individual holding proprietary rights.

The bureau suggested to add addition yellow highlighted text.

Rule 2: In amplification of Article 17.1 (GREX), entries may be exhibited by the author, compiler, editor, publisher, sponsoring organization or society, or any other individual holding proprietary rights. However, that literature entry will always be listed under the name used when it was first entered into competition irrespective of who might submit it subsequently for competition.

As per the discussion and suggestion, it was decided to share multiple options with the delegates and take their feedback to make necessary suitable changes.

Point 2: To consider all catalogues under Monographs

In current Guidelines, the non-periodical catalogues are under Monographs and periodical catalogues are under Periodicals.

As per the discussion and suggestion, it was decided to send an email to all delegates to ask for their input to make necessary changes..

2- PRESENTATION: JUDGING LITERATURE EXHIBITS - REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURE

Ari Muhonen delivered excellent presentation on the subject.

3- PRESENTATION: LITERATURE SREV, GUIDELINES, AND SUPPLEMENTARY RULES AND GETTING THE CHANGES IMPLEMENTED

Norman Banfield proposed to have single document for the FIP Literature Regulations with bullet points and in simple English.
